

Formerly based in Ramsgate Fr Laurence's community have now moved and taken up residence at St Augustine's Abbey in Chilworth, Surrey.



Istvan Ferenczy - has been a student leader and leader of a school of evangelization. He oversees many of the community's conferences and travels preaching and ministering internationally. He is a gifted leader, preacher and anointed in prayer ministry and healing. Istvan graduated with a degree in computer engineering and has lived and worked in the Community for over 5 years.
